WHAT TO PACK

KIDS CAMP IS MESSY!

Recreation during Kids Camp is often messy! Our camp has zero desire to be the dress code police, so have some basic, general guidelines that we encourage everyone to follow! Please remember: clothes and shoes will get messy, possibly muddy – for this reason please do not send expensive clothing. **We recommend two pairs of clothes per day at minimum.**

- Older, casual play clothes and shoes are needed.
- Tank tops are okay, as long as they are not spaghetti straps, and as long as they don't hang open low on the sides.
- Shorts - for girls, the finger tip rule is a good one to follow (when the child's arm is hanging straight down on their side if their shorts are at, or below, the tip of the finger then they are generally long enough). For boys - generally boys shorts are long enough.

- For services what is worn during the day is acceptable. We just ask that you dress modestly.
- Shoes must be worn at all times, including to and from the pool, as regulated by the state insurance board.
- Cover clothing must be worn to and from the pool and lake. This includes boys and girls!

CLOTHES

- To help children get dressed quicker and not run out of clean clothes while at camp, we suggest placing their clothes in gallon-sized ziplock bags that are individually labeled.
- Please label **all** clothing with your child's name on the tags.
- Swim suits - Must be covered at all times on their way to and from the pool. Two piece bathing suits are allowed for girls as long as there is no "belly" showing.
- Goggles for swimming.



WHAT TO PACK

(continued)

SHOES

- Tennis shoes – good for running, jumping, and play time
- Water shoes – flip flops/water shoes/sandals – good for lake and pool time
- Extra pair of shoes in case one of the others ends up broken or muddy

OTHER ITEMS

- Bible, Notepad & Pen
- Linens (sheets and blankets for twin size mattress) or sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Towels (separate for bathing and pool/lake) and wash cloths
- Body soap, Shampoo, Conditioner, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Deodorant etc.
- Refillable water bottle (unless purchasing the camp bottle)
- Sunscreen, bug spray
- Seasoned campers suggest bringing: sharpies and flashlights

PLEASE LEAVE THESE ITEMS AT HOME

- Cell Phones – these will be taken up and not returned until we are back at the church. *Please know, we have been praying for your children to have a week filled with God-Moments. Over the years we have learned that cellphones and other like devices can often distract them while they are at camp. If your child brings a cellphone they will not be allowed to keep it with them.*
- Video games
- Anything expensive!

DON'T FORGET

When you drop your child(ren) off please be sure to have these things ready!

- All daily medication required must come to drop off ready in a ziplock bag with original prescription bottles. This will go directly to leadership – please do not pack in suitcase. A Medicine Form is required to be filled out by a parent or guardian upon arrival. (Only necessary if your child requires medicine daily –THIS INCLUDES NIGHTLY MELATONIN – **ALL** medicine **MUST** be in the original prescription bottle. The camp will not accept, and therefore not administer, any loose prescriptions in ziplock bag, daily pill organizer, etc.)
- Send spending money for the snack shack/camp store (\$5 a day is suggested). This will go directly to leadership – please do not pack in suitcase.
- Suitcase packed with items on packing list.
